




Merry Christmas and Happy New year 2019, dear friends!

What's new for the past two months?

1. First of all a huge thank you for your support both financial and your prayers of our boy Petrus, who was hit by a car in October and received serious trauma to his head. After being in a medically-induced coma and having surgery, he is recovering very fast, with the help of doctors and prayers from people all over the world. This is God's miracle which we (to be honest) didn't expect, the doctors didn't give us any hopes. Now he can sit, he smiles, he says some words, he tries to hold his head, please keep praying for him!



2. Planning ahead with our team at the end of each month helps us to include different activities with kids. Each week has a topic, the week of "Professions" we visited an IT





company, on Math week we went to the Evrika museum, on Geography week we had a quizz show with Geography questions trying to motivate the kids to learn more.

On November 23 we had the final training in this year for the local government social workers, the main topic of discussion was "Discipline", our psychologists Olga and Iryna taught about methods of correction for negative behavior and taught social staff how to create therapeutic fairy tales and apply them.
- 4. In November and December two of our staff members had an opportunity to attend a special course "Art-therapy in working with traumatized people". This therapy can be an important tool for working with individuals, and parental work groups.



5. We would like to introduce our new staff member, Olga Bondarenko, our speech therapist. WE are happy to see our team growing!
